What will your services cost?

How long does the process take?

A preliminary presentation is a meeting where we present our design concept, basic drawings, color scheme, key fabrics and furnishings, and initial budget to make sure we are all on the same page.

The final design phase is presented as soon as you have made your decision. This will include all working drawings, tear sheets of furnishings, samples of fabrics and the final budget which will have all the costs, item by item, on everything you need to complete your project.

How does purchasing work?

Your completed design project includes a detailed budget. You choose what pieces you want to order and then we create a proposal that details those items and prices. After you approve and sign the proposal, and return it with your deposit check, we will order your selections and provide you with delivery timelines. Of course, we will follow this process through from start to finish.
